1. Possum Hollow Road drop boxes - Range Resources, Markwest and Sunoco - status of the timeline on repairs.

Ten-Mile completed work in mid-December 2021. At this time repairs are acceptable to the Twp. The engineer can confirm all work the following week while at other meetings in Township.

3. Markwest permanent access road. John Mathues, Permit Coordinator for Marathon Petroleum / Markwest sent a Driveway Permit Application and a survey drawing the Township regarding the construction of a permanent access road MarkWest Liberty Midstream & Resources, LLC would like to construct off Fox Road in Hopewell Township for access to an existing natural gas pipeline valve site. Permit granted.

4. Morrow Hill Road DGLVR Project

Township has sent personnel to DGLVR training for next cycle grant application.

5. Whitegate Road - Status

Easements submitted, upon signing bid documents can be advertised. Scheduling meeting with residents for next week after quarantine.

6. DGLVR Bonds Release Request. An email was received from South Coast Surety Insurance Services, LLC regarding the 2020 Dirt Gravel and Low Volume Road Project numbers M21, M22, M23 and M24 for East Crossroads Road and Possum Hollow Road. They are requesting the release of Bond No. UCSX372X3391 for those projects.

Section 4.10, specially 4.10.5.7 of the contract relates to protection of the roadway, etc... This must be discussed, as the contraction may want to argue the point, although some compensation my be possible.
