Mr. Derrick Carlisle inquired regarding a complaint he submitted earlier in 2023 regarding the West Middletown Fire Department. Mr. Carlisle was directed to take up his concern with the Fire Department as they are a separate entity from the Township. Mr. Carlisle requested permit applications from the township office. The Standard applications, which are provided to all residents requesting applications, were provided to Mr. Carlisle via U.S. Postal Mail. Mr. Carlisle had concerns regarding the fee for a Zoning Permit for an agricultural building he indicated that he intends to construct on his property to replace an agricultural building lost to fire and questioned why he would be charged a fee.
